FLIGHTS TO AMSTERDAM

Board your flights to Amsterdam. No Air costs have been included in the price. Air will become available 11 months prior to the trip.

Tuesday, June 06

Arrival/Amsterdam/Monnickendam

ARRIVAL IN AMSTERDAM

Upon arrival in Amsterdam, gather your luggage and proceed to customs. Once outside of Customs meet your Amsterdam Tour Directors.

AALSMEER FLOWER AUCTION

CONTINUE TO MONNICKENDAM

On to Monnickendam, located north of Amsterdam about 10 miles. Stop at the requested Lake Land / WaterFront Hotel that is located on the lake, just outside of Monnickendam, a historic small and very much quaint village dating back to the 13th century.

We continue to Royal The Hague, the seat of the government and home of the Royal Family.

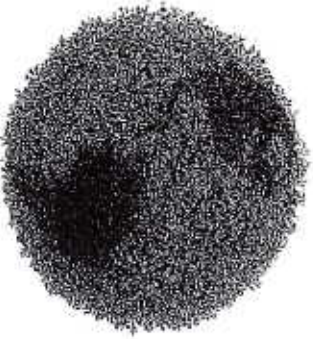
