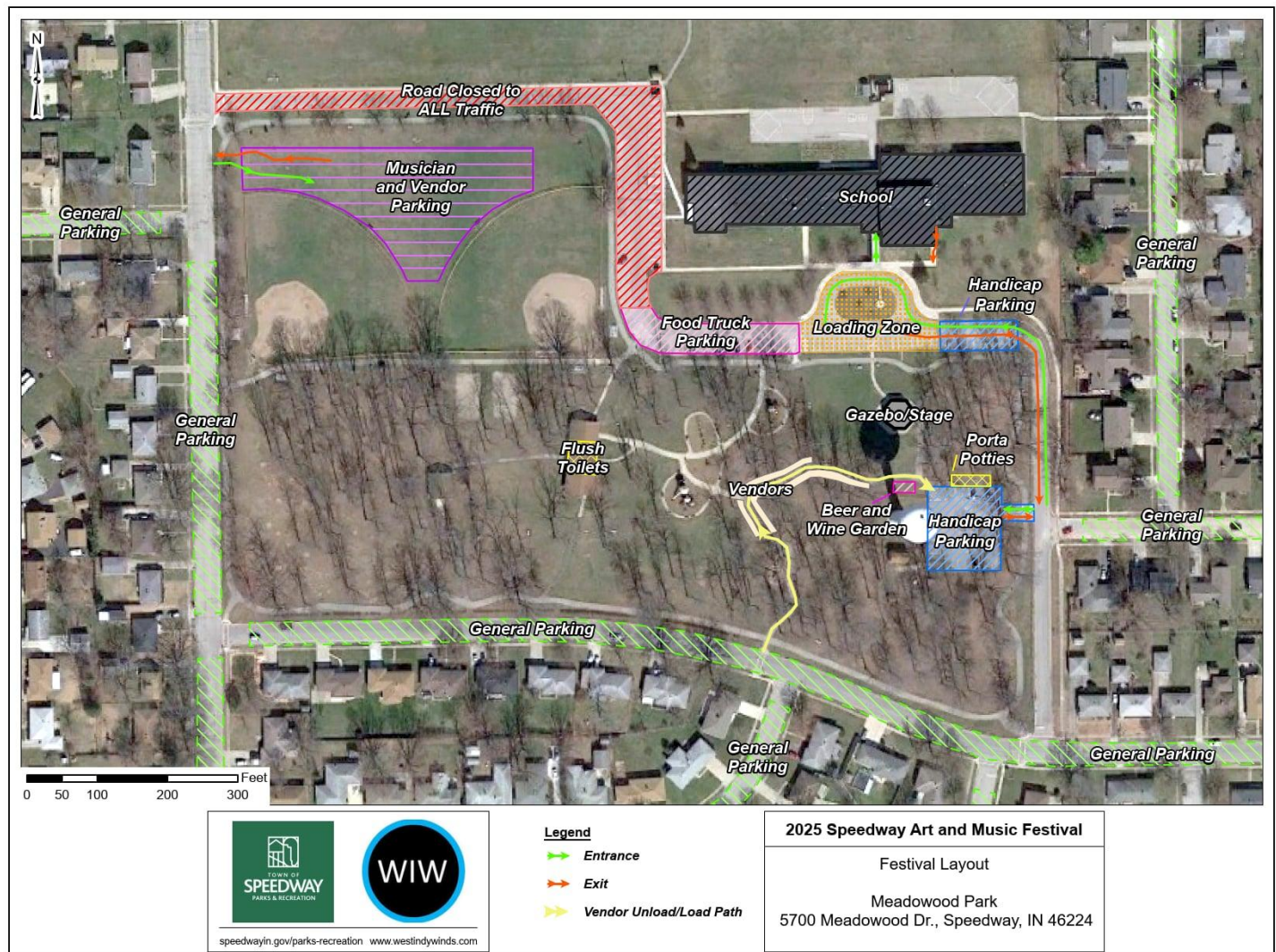
PERCUSSION/EQUIPMENT PROVIDED

WARM UP AREA

Speedway Public Schools is allowing us to use the gymnasium inside of Wheeler Elementary for a warm up area. You will see on the map that this is a short walk to the gazebo. You will be allowed in the rehearsal area on the hour before your performance time. You will have a band guide with you during rehearsal to answer your questions. We are asking that **ONLY** percussionists and directors arrive on stage 15 minutes before performance time to talk with the stage crew about setup. The band guide will release remaining members of the band to the stage when the stage is prepared for the band, that way we can reduce the amount of congestion on stage.

DIRECTOR CHECK-IN

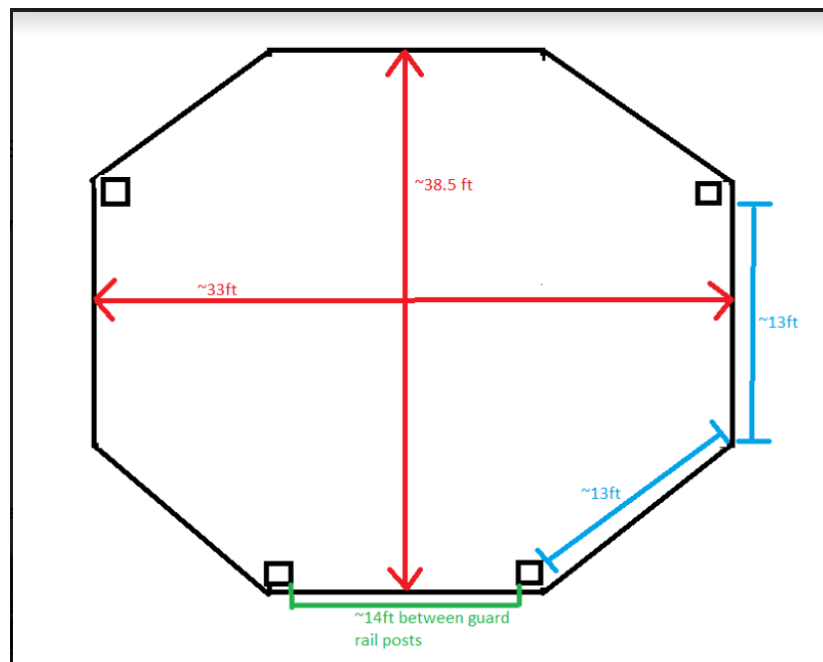
Please have your director check-in upon arrival so that we can provide any last minute details/reminders. Check-in table will be located outside the warm up area underneath the school's awning.

GAZEBO

Meadowood Gazebo is where the bands will be performing. Please note that performers will be entering and exiting from the FRONT side of the gazebo only. Should you have a performer unable to navigate the steps, the backside that does not have steps will be accessible.



Measurements are indicated below. In 2024, we were able to fit our largest band of 60+ performers in this area.



OTHER THINGS TO NOTE

We ask band members NOT bring their instrument cases on stage, and leave them inside of the school building. That way we can have a quicker exit off stage and allow our stage crew to maximize their time setting up for the next band.

Directors, we ask that you please finish by the :45 of the hour so that we can have the 15 minutes between bands to set up the stage. We will have a timer indicating when you have 5 minutes remaining.
